### Safety Code Statement:

Given the nature of Rowing and the inherent dangers associated with all water sports, we are committed to providing the safest possible environment for all of our members and participants so that they may enjoy their sport, devoid of all unnecessary risks. No member or participant should ever be put in a situation of danger and all precautions necessary should be taken to protect our members and participants from all forms of harm.
